

Main Street Unionville Community Vision Plan – Next Steps



Following discussion and approval at our January members meeting, URA submitted final comments on the vision plan to the City on January 8, and made a deputation to Development Services Committee on January 13.

The matter was discussed at an official Council meeting on January 13. A large number of motions were passed, including the following key ones:

- Endorse Main Street Vision Plan in principle as a guideline for a future Secondary Plan for the area and as a guideline when initiating proposed projects in the public and private realms.
- Explore opportunities for the focus areas and parking optimization recommendations.
- Initiate high level discussions with TRCA on the parking platform on the flood plain east of Main Street and with the School Board on opening the connection between Parkview School and Fonthill Lane.
- Investigate options for the GO rail crossing at Highway 7 that would not involve grade separation.
- Provide staff memo on role, responsibilities and funding options for a trustee or coordinator to work with local businesses and property owners to implement the plan. Councillors to meet with these stakeholders on this matter.
- Reconstitute Main Street Unionville Committee to act as advisory committee to oversee and assist in implementing plan.
- Refer installation of public washrooms on Main Street to 2015 budget process.

URA and UVA will continue to closely monitor and participate in the progress of these activities.
